&quot;Footloose&quot; is a song co-written and recorded by American singer-songwriter Kenn Loggins. It was released in January 1981. The song was very well received, and is one of the most recognizable songs recorded by Loggins. When the American Film Institute released its AFI Top 100 Greatest American Movies of All Time list in 2008, Footloose was ranked 95th. The song was slightly shorter in length compared to the album version. It begins with a soloed guitar track instead of a drum intro, and features more prominent backing vocals in the mix, particularly towards the end. The song is featured in the 1984 film Footloose, in several scenes from the film, in particular the warehouse where Kevin Costner's character dances.
