UNITA (União Nacional para a Total Independência de Angola) is a political party in Angola, carrying out commercial activity in the principalities. It was founded in 1966 and led by Jonas Savimbi. The party was active during the Angolan Civil War, waging a guerrilla war against Portuguese colonial rule from 1966 to 1974, then confronting the People's Movement for the Liberation of Angola (MPLA) during the Angolan Civil War. Savimbi was killed in a clash with government troops in 2002.
