Each Minesweeper game starts out with a grid of unmarked Squares. After clicking one of these squares, some of the squares will disappear, and some will remain blank; and some will have numbers on them. It's your job to use the numbers for figuring out which squares are safe that you can click on without blowing up. And why are they safe that you can click on without blowing up? Well, the numbers tell you how many bombs are adjacent to that square. So, if a square has a 1 next to it, that means there is only one bomb adjacent to it. If a square has a 2 next to it, that means there are two bombs adjacent to it. If a square has a 3 next to it, that means there are three bombs adjacent to it. If a square has a 4 next to it, that means there are four bombs adjacent to it. If a square has a 5 next to it, that means there are five bombs adjacent to it. If a square has a 6 next to it, that means there are six bombs adjacent to it. If a square has a 7 next to it, that means there are seven bombs adjacent to it. If a square has an 8 next to it, that means there are eight bombs adjacent to it. If a square has no number next to it, that means there are no bombs adjacent to it. If you click on a square that has a bomb next to it, you lose. If you click on a square that has no bomb next to it, you win. So, the goal of the game is to click on all the squares that have no bombs next to them without clicking on any squares that have bombs next to them. It's a challenging game, but it's also a fun one.
