The company produced &#129297; over 20 films, including Fox Searchlight's critically acclaimed hit Birdman, which was nominated for nine Academy Awards, winning four Oscars, &#129297; including Best Picture, and grossed more than R\$100 million in global box office revenue.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;Worldview Entertainment was founded in &#129297; 2007 by Chairman and CEO, Christopher Woodrow,[1] and Maria Cestone. Molly Connors joined the company in 2009 as COO. Worldview &#129297; Entertainment signed with Creative Artists Agency (CAA) in 2010 and has since become the agency&#39;s top film finance and production &#129297; client. Sarah E. Johnson, daughter of Franklin Resources Chairman, Charles B. Johnson, became a partner and investor in the company &#129297; in 2011. Worldview established a four-year R\$30 million credit facility with Comerica in 2013 to provide debt financing for the company&#39;s &#129297; films, which coincided with the infusion of R\$40 million in new equity from existing investors. The R\$70 million doubled the company&#39;s capital &#129297; base.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;The company&#39;s first film was William Friedkin&#39;s black comedy, Killer Joe, which it financed along with Voltage Pictures in 2010. &#129297; The film premiered at the 2011 Venice Film Festival before making its North American debut at the Toronto International Film &#129297; Festival, where it was sold
